• Cynefin Group - community engagement:

Mari Wynn Tudur, Senior Rural Housing Enabler, Grwp Cynefin and Ian Gillespie, North Wales Housing joined the meeting. They explained that North Wales Housing have comissioned Grwp Cynefin to carry out a suvey of housing in the Eglwys Bach area. They will be asking residents to complete a survey to identify their housing needs and ask for their opinion on current housing in this area. The closing day for the survey in 28 April.

An Open Day on 24 April from 4.30-6.30pm will be held in the village hall and is an opportunity for local people to come and ask questions. Sarth (Single Acess Route to Housing) who are responsible for social housing will also be there. It is also important that local people fill in the feedback form. A comprehensive housing needs report will then be written for the area.



• Community Support Officer PCSO - community engagement:

PCSO Elin Harlow, North Wales Police joined the meeting. Elin explained that she had only received 2 phone calls regarding anti-social behaviour and said that it was important that residents reported any anti-social behaviour through phoning 111 or online. The Councillors asked Elin if it would be possible to have more of a 'police presence' in the village. Speeding on Ffordd Ty Gwyn was also discussed and Elin said that one of the PC's could check speeding on the road using a speed gun.

• The Coronation – Merched y Wawr/WI – contribution:

The Councillors discussed the above and decided that in future a letter would need to be sent by any society to the Clerk to ask for a contribution and an explanation as to what the contribution would be spent on as it was needed for the Council's records.
