BRIDGE AND BRYN HIR

There have been concerns about the width of the channel beneath the bridge. Engineers have come out

and spent time at the bridge and will be monitoring the situation. It is at least 4 foot (1.5m) wider than before.

HORSES

There are concerns about horses using the footpath along the CARROG footpath. Horses can erode the footpath and when meeting pedestrians, cause alarm.

Please use the river bed and not the



footpath, and please do not use the bridge. Advisory signs will soon be put in place to remind horse riders of these restrictions.

STONES

We have received complaints about the piles of stones heaped up on Bryn Hir after the building of the new bridge. They are earmarked for the repairing of the eroded track leading up from the river, and will disappear in due course.



BINS

Soon we will be going over to a 3weekly

collection. If this will prove a problem for you, please ringfor help in managing your waste. (You may be eligible for a larger bin, more bins, nappy/medical waste disposal etc
